





DID YOU KNOW ?

AI interacts favorably with pharmaceutical firms and health care personnel. It can speed drug approval times by 40% and cut costs by 30%.

AI doesn't replace doctors or scientists, it augments them.

AI automates documentation, billing, and scheduling which in turn allows oncologists to spend more time on patient care.

The near future will bring many more positive examples of using AI to enhance medical care.


